- 7. You will notice that your application has been automatically assigned an application Number which has to be noted for all further correspondence.
- 8. Immediately after the online registration, a hard copy of the filled in application form duly signed by you along with supporting documents should be sent to the Principal, Rajagiri Higher Secondary School, Rajagiri P O Kalamassery, Kerala by post or by hand.
- 9. The supporting documents to be sent along with application form are (1) a Demand Draft for a sum of Rs.200/(Rupees Two hundred only)towards service charge drawn in favour of Principal Rajagiri HSS payable at KALAMASSERY,(2)Self-attested photocopies of educational/Mark sheet of SSLC/ equivalent Examinations etc.(3)Any other information candidates feel to submit. No original documents are to be sent along with the application form.

Our Mission

The school endeavours to provide an eco-friendly atmosphere for an integral development of multiple intelligences and skills of a learner through a continuous learning process with a research mind to face the challenges of the modern world.

**Location:** The school nestles in the lap of lush green campus spreading over an area of 20 acres at Kalamassery in Ernakulam District, Kerala. It is a treasure trove of flora and fauna having serene beauty. It, being an eco-friendly and litter-free campus, provides an excellent learning ambience for each and every pupil.

Establishment and Management

It is an English medium Higher Secondary School having classes from I to XII with new curriculum and syllabus of State/NCERT. ICSE syllabus is introduced from 2008-2009 onwards. It is an unaided school recognized by the Govt. of Kerala, and is semi-residential.

The school has a humble beginning in 1964. It was established by the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI), an indigenous religious congregation of the Roman Catholic Church. Rev Fr. Francis Sales, CMI (1904-1984) the then provincial of Sacred Heart Province, Rajagiri, Kalamassery is the founding father of the school. He is reverentially remembered for articulating, nurturing and fostering the CMI mission of education at Rajagiri, a mission that is a continuous experience for the present stake holders.

The school grew in size and stature with the passage of time. Young Rajagiri was fondly looked after by Fr. Gregory Karotemprel CMI (former Bishop of Rajkot Diocese) and Fr. Aaron Vithayathil CMI who are rightly called the pioneers of the school. The late Mr. Joseph V. Manjooran being the retired headmaster of St. Albert's School, brought a wealth of knowledge and experience to the school during its inception. While Mr. Manjooran served as headmaster (1964-

1976), the administrative function was carried out by the pioneer fathers. Over the years the following helmsmen have been rendering fruitful and steadfast service as heads of the institution with the able help of the faculty.

School and Campus facilities

**Chapel:** In order to spiritually enrich the learner the school has a chapel for morning meditation and noon prayers. This improves concentration and inculcates values in the learner.

**Faculty:** Rajagiri Higher Secondary School has a perfect blend of young and experienced faculty to motivate and facilitate the learning process of young minds to higher levels of academic excellence. The school also has an extension team of committed instructors to enhance the aesthetic and athletic skills of the learner. The learner gets instructed in the fields of vocal music, dance, instrumental music (guitar, organ, violin, drums, jazz, tabala etc.), dramas, roller skating and swimming.

**Library:** The school library is an active and well-equipped hub where the learner has maximum access and is cared to with diligent care. It has a total collection of 55,000 books, which ranges from the very old to the very new.

**Labs:** The school has separate and well-equipped labs for computer, physics, chemistry, botany, zoology and languages.

**Computer Lab:** Installed with 40 computers, multimedia under network environment, the lab has laser printer, scanner, LCD projector and is manned by three teachers and connected with the world for the latest information and technology.

**Science and Language Lab:** To motivate the learner's desire for knowledge the school has separate labs for science subjects and languages. The labs are well-equipped and maintained by a team of dedicated teachers. Active boards have been installed in class rooms.

**Sports:** Four basketball courts with hi-tech fibre finish and a football surrounded by emerald lawns and nurtured throughout the year by the school, the sporting prowess of the learner is honed by the management with an area of almost 2 acres dedicated towards this purpose.

**Bus Service:** The school provides transportation facilities to the students from LKG to Class XII from Aluva, Parur, Thevara etc.

Boys

- (Class I to IV): Navy blue shorts, white shirt with half sleeves. (On Wednesdays: White shorts, House colour T-shirt)
- (Class V to X): Navy blue trousers, white shirt with half sleeves. (On Wednesdays: White trousers, House colour T-shirt)
- (Class XI & XII): Navy blue trousers, pinstriped white blue shirt with half sleeves (On Wednesdays: White trousers, colour T-shirt)
- Black shoes, navy blue neck-tie, navy blue socks, school belt on all days except Wednesdays.
- White canvas shoes with white socks on all Wednesdays.
- ID card on all days.

Girls

Higher Secondary Course (Classes XI-XII)

The School was upgraded as Higher Secondary School in 2002. NCERT syllabus is followed.

2. Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics & Computer Science

A student has to select one of the languages (Malayalam/Hindi/French) for Higher Secondary Course.

Admission to Classes I to XII

The School admits fresh students (both boys and girls) in classes from I to XII. Application for admission is to be submitted online. Instructions for online registration are given below:

1. First, please log on to the school website: [www.rajagirihss.org](http://www.rajagirihss.org) and read the prospectus carefully. Rajagiri Higher Secondary school is unaided and recognized by the Govt. of Kerala with English as medium of instruction. At present, we follow ICSE syllabus in classes I - VII and State Syllabus in classes VIII – X and NCERT syllabus in Classes XI and XII
2. Boarding facilities for boys are available at the campus
3. Application for Higher Secondary Course –Plus Two course-(Classes XI-XII) should be submitted online within 10 days from the date of announcement of results of SSLC Examination of current academic year. Students studying in other streams (CBSE etc) can also provisionally apply taking into consideration of their final score at class X examination.
4. There are two types of application forms: General application form for classes up to X and Plus Two
